<i>September</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First assembly for grade 12 students</li> <li>• College Information Program (CIP)</li> <li>• Various college / university / military presentations at St. Ignatius (these continue throughout semester 1)</li> </ul>
<i>October</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ontario College Application website open</li> <li>• University Information Program (UIP)</li> <li>• Lakehead University presentation to grade 12 students</li> <li>• Guidance counsellors visit classes to explain application procedures</li> </ul>
<i>November</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ontario University Application website opens (PIN numbers in mid-late November)</li> <li>• Confederation College presentation to grade 12 students</li> <li>• Confederation College Open House (gr. 11 &amp; 12)</li> <li>• Skilled Trades Presentation (schools take turn hosting)</li> </ul>
<i>December</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lakehead University Grade 12 Preview Day</li> <li>• Early offers of university admission possible</li> <li>• Awards Trust scholarship booklets available</li> </ul>
<i>January</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ontario university applications due. Admission offers begin shortly thereafter and can continue (in several rounds) until May. Students may start accepting their desired offer.</li> <li>• Grad photos (book online at <a href="http://www.lifetouch.ca/tbay">www.lifetouch.ca/tbay</a>) – any retakes usually happen in the spring</li> <li>• Guidance counsellor visit classes to give reminders and answer questions about post-secondary applications</li> </ul>
<i>February</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ontario college applications due. Admission offers begin shortly thereafter and can continue (in several rounds) until the end of April. Students may start accepting their desired offer</li> <li>• Guidance counsellors do course planning presentations with grades 9, 10, 11 and a graduation update presentation with grade 12 students</li> <li>• Lakehead University Grade 11 Preview Day</li> </ul>
<i>March</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Awards Trust Scholarship Applications due</li> <li>• Letter home to parents / guardians of potential grads to explain event costs and deadlines</li> <li>• March Break tours available at Con. College and Lakehead University</li> </ul>
<i>April</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduation “Pay Day” at St. Ignatius (payment for graduation events)</li> <li>• We would hope that grade 12 students have their community hours done by now</li> </ul>
<i>May</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline to confirm offers of admission to Ontario colleges (pay any necessary deposits)</li> <li>• Advanced Placement and French DELF exams</li> </ul>
<i>June</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline to confirm offers of admission to Ontario universities (pay any necessary deposits)</li> <li>• Mandatory assemblies for Grade 12 Potential Graduates (convocation procedures and Safe Grad)</li> <li>• Graduation ceremonies (Mass, luncheon, convocation)</li> </ul>

1. If you are dealing with schools outside of Ontario, or with private college / universities, please check the due dates for each individual school.
2. Scholarship deadlines will vary. Scholarships start arriving in September and will continue until May / June.
3. Marks are transferred to OUAC / OCAS in November, February, April and July.
